Jarrar, Allam Mohammed (1954-2017)

Born near Ramallah in 1954; studied Medicine at Rustow University, USSR, graduating in 1980; Executive Committee member of the Union of Palestinian Medical Relief Committees (UPMRC) and Director of its Rehabilitation Program; Vice-President of the Palestinian Council for Peace and Justice; worked as a senior medical officer for UNRWA and managed community-based rehabilitation and primary health care in Palestine, Jordan, Morocco, UAE, Afghanistan, Lebanon, Iraq, and Bahrain; worked with the Palestinian Medical Relief Society (PMRS); was active in the PNGO network and member of its Steering Committee; served as Secretary-General of the Palestinian National Initiative (Al-Mubadara), founded in 2004; acted as spokesman of the Mustafa Barghouthi campaign during the 2005 Presidential elections; was an

honorary member of the NGO Development Center, Ramallah; passed away in Nablus on 8 March 2017.
